Here are your choice of projects for this term. Please bring them in no earlier than October 18th. Enjoy completing as many of these as you wish with your child and they can present their hard work to their class!

<p>1</p> <p>Create your family tree. Spend time talking to your family about how everyone is related and where you are on the tree. You could even add photographs if you wish!</p>	<p>2</p> <p>Create a self-portrait using materials of your choice. You may use natural materials, you may choose to paint, you may choose collage. Whatever you choose, make sure you look carefully at your features!</p>	<p>3</p> <p>Write a list of 10 things that make you special! (There will be more than 10). You could be special because you speak another language, you wear glasses or that you are exceptionally good at running!</p>	<p>4</p> <p>Create a big poster all about yourself to share with your class when you bring it in. Try to include something that we don't already know about you.</p>
<p>5</p> <p>Look at photographs of how you have grown. Maybe look at 1 for each year of your life so far. Talk to an adult about the things you could do at each stage!</p>	<p>6</p> <p>Your name is very special because it is yours. Can you write it? How many different ways can you write it? With lego? Leaves? Fingerprints? In flour? What can you come up with?</p>	<p>7</p> <p>Keep a feelings diary. You are allowed to have lots of different feelings; you might feel happy, sad, angry, excited etc. Write your emotion in your diary. Can you say why you feel that way?</p>	<p>8</p> <p>Make a YOU puzzle. Find a photo of yourself. Ask an adult to cut the photo into pieces and stick them to card. Now you can complete the puzzle!</p>
