The purpose of homework is:

- To support learning in the core skills.
- To find out new things to complement knowledge in your child's topic of learning.
- To include Parents/Carers in their child's learning journey.

What can you expect?

Home work will come out as MUST do and COULD do. This will enable you to do the expected minimum with your child/ren and for those parents and children that wish to do more that option is also there. This will usually be based on the topic areas covered that week. You will know each week what your child has been learning and are therefore able to support them. Any work completed will be marked in accordance with the school marking policy.

What we do not want

- We do not want homework to be a battle between you and your child.
- We do not want homework to be a chore.
- We do not want homework to be all consuming. We appreciate that there is a life outside of school.
- Work that is not your child's.

The Homework

- Basic Skills Homework will come out every week in the form of spellings/phonics, reading expectations, maths recall facts and possibly handwriting.
- Exceptions to this will be Yr 6 and Yr 2 SATs preparation homework.
- Any specific intervention your child may be doing that requires additional support at home.
